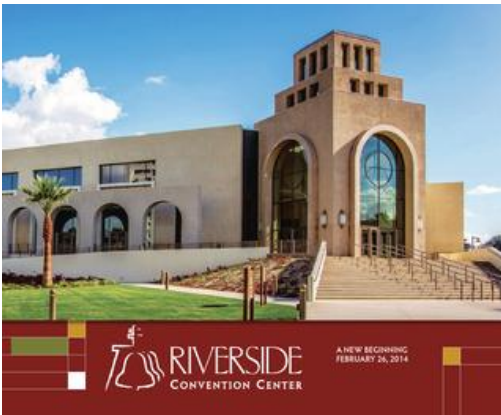




KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!
