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What Do Colleges Need?

Help with initiatives:

- AB 705
- Guided Pathways
- Vision for Success

AB 705

- Often students will need additional support when placed in transfer classes.
- Online courses aligned with the OEI Course Design rubric have higher success rates.
- Services like online tutoring are embedded in classes.



Guided Pathways

- One primary goal is to reduce the time to degree (number of units).
- Students often wait for a capstone or GE course.
- Online course finder (Finish Faster Online) provides access to courses statewide.



Student Centered Funding Formula

Colleges still need enrollment, plus:

- Completion numbers
- Transfer numbers
- CTE certificates/unit minimum

Vision for Success

- Increase completion by 20%
- Increase state transfer by 35%
- Decrease average units for degree
- Reduce equity and regional gaps
