

The Joint-Use 21st Century Post-Secondary Education Site is a unique collaboration between the Milpitas Unified School District (MUSD) and the San José Evergreen Community College District (SJECCD) to establish an Educational Innovation Lab.

SJECCD PROJECT VISION

- Serving the needs of the residents of Milpitas
- Providing seamless access to higher educational opportunities

MUSD PROJECT VISION

- Creating a facility to allow access to college level courses while completing high school curriculum
- Providing opportunities for students to realize future dreams through career and college pathways

Project and Service Vision

- | Post-secondary opportunities to be integrated to the Milpitas High School curriculum and community at large
- | Strengthening pathways leading to 4-year college (CSU & UC)
- | Workforce training and CTE emphasis
- | Adult education opportunities
- | Dual enrollment for high school students (A-G + transferrable units)
- | Innovative programs (i.e. Coding Academy, Robotics)
- | Instill best practices (high school and college)




