Set out to assess and match industry concentration with employer needs


- ► Inform a more robust collaborative model around available and stackable skills-oriented programs

- Facilitate identification of entry-level and middle skills required by employers in multiple sectors
- Convene 3 roundtable meetings of the Accelerator project under the Future of Work Initiative banner around the state





Where are Opportunity Zones in California?


- > 879 Census Tracts in California

Features

- ► Identifies all credentials aligned with occupations for all sectors
- Compiles all nationally recognized quality measures for every occupation
- ► Knowledge, skills and competencies listed for every occupation
- Credentials ranked on nationally recognized obtainability measures (cost, knowledge, work experience, exam requirements...)



CREDENTIAL ENGINE

- Programs published to the credential engine (when approved by designated stakeholder)
- Credential Engine adds marketing visibility for programs to industry and prospective students
- Makes Credentials Transparent and Reveals the Marketplace of Credentials
